Many years ago my family went through some very difficult times. Some of you know about some of it and a few of you know about all of it. I sometimes compare it with the trials of Job, though on a lesser scale. It involved family, job, money, health, and friends, all in one go. Some good friends formed the "Peterson Partners" and for a month we were provided with food, groceries, cards, calls, and visits every day. I can't tell you what a glorious blessing that was for us.

Everybody goes through tough times and the body of Christ is there to help one another out. As 1 Cor. 12:26 tells us, "When one part of the body suffers, we all suffer" (or at least we should).

Right now Texas is suffering from a hurricane and soon Florida will be as well. The Northwest is on fire and Montana alone has over a million acres burned. 4 members from my Lutheran Early Response Team are going down to Texas to help. I expect thousands of Lutherans will be there, and many thousands of other denominations. They will provide construction help, counseling,
